America's Great Seal is a valuable visual teaching aid. It serves not only as the nation's coat-of-arms and America's official seal but it also serves as an emblem for the nation's civil religion ... Christianity. The U.S. State Department is responsible for the Great Seal. The department maintains that the Great Seal symbolizes the beliefs and values America's founding fathers wished to pass on to future generations.


The Great Seal Bible Insert is a full color, four page, self-adhering insert with a patriotic ribbon page marker that identifies twenty eight elements of the Great Seal and facilitates four means of study for each element; Key words are in italic for a concordance word search; Relevant book/chapter/verse are listed for each element; Thompson Chain-Reference[®] numbers are provided for each; *ACT* 5 Management Training System[™] codes are inserted for each element. *ACT* 5 codes also offer a convenient system for personal Bible margin marking.

The Great Seal of the United States History

Congress commissioned the seal design in 1776 ... the same day America declared her independence. Secretary of Congress Charles Thomson produced the first seal design and legal description (blazon) approved by congress (June 20, 1782). Secretary Thomson was a fiery patriot as well a classical scholar who wrote the first American Bible translation. His seal design captured the Biblical worldview of America's founding period. The State Department occasionally changed the seal design during times of civil stress. The beginning of the twentieth century marked an end to seal changes. A near likeness to the official design appears on the back of the dollar bill.

Note: Charles Thomson, the seal designer/Bible translator, and F. Charles Thompson, the Bible Reference System designer, may be unrelated (though they shared a common love of service to God and countrymen during particularly trying times).

THE GREAT SEAL

America's official seal is also the emblem of its religion ... Christianity. The founding fathers established and sustained America with their Christian faith. They symbolized the beliefs and values they wished to pass on to future generations in the national seal. Shown below are the four major components of the Great Seal of The United States and described in the founding generation's worldview.



The Star Crest is the most important component. It occupies the exalted position on the seal front and serves as a visionary statement for the nation. Some ancients wore a crest as a unique *mark* on the forehead.



The Eagle and symbols is America's coat-of-arms. They represent the three branches of the nation's government and its constitutional authority. The bird is divine deliverance...on the wings of an eagle.



The Gold Pyramid symbolizes the American society managing their Creators physical property in accord to His will. Citizens promote the *Novus Ordo Seclorum* with wealth they derived from His Earth.



The Eye Crest at the apex of the pyramid symbolizes the fulfillment of the founder's vision. The thirteen glory beams represent the individual states of the American republic flooding the world with the Gospel.

The seven elements of each component are explained inside.
